

CRIME ACTIVITY ALERT

On Monday, March 21st, between the hours of 11:45 a.m. and 12:00 noon, two homes were burglarized in the 1200 and 1300 blocks of Krist Drive. In both instances, an unknown person or persons forced entry into the home, entered, and took valuables.

Officers were already in the area conducting enhanced residential patrol and were therefore able to respond to the locations within less than two minutes. Unfortunately, the suspects had already fled the scene, likely in an unknown type of vehicle.

As in the previous incidents, officers processed both crime scenes, recovered forensic evidence, and have submitted that evidence for DNA processing.

Although we had already made some shift assignment changes to supplement our dayshift patrol force, we will continue to implement other measures and the use of additional resources as we endeavor to solve these crimes.

Those of you whose homes are equipped with alarms should arm your alarm each and every time you leave your home, even if you will be gone only for a few minutes.

If you are home or in the area and you hear an alarm sounding from a neighbor's home, call and report this to the police department immediately. This may result in an even quicker response time by your patrol officers.

As always, we encourage each of you to be observant and immediately report any suspicious activity to your police department.
