

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-XX**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRING VALLEY VILLAGE, TEXAS EXTENDING A STATE OF DISASTER DUE TO EXTENDED FREEZING WEATHER, POWER OUTAGES AND LACK OF WATER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Greg Abbott, Governor of the State of Texas, entered a declaration of disaster on Friday, February 12, 2021 as in anticipation of extended freezing weather and power outages; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City of Spring Valley Village, Texas issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster on Sunday, February 14, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Spring Valley Village, Texas find it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of its citizens to extend this declaration of disaster for an additional thirty (30) days; and

**WHEREAS**, by this Declaration, the City Council declares all rules and regulations that may inhibit or prevent prompt response to this threat suspended for the duration of the incident; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the authority granted to the Mayor under the Texas Disaster Act, the Mayor, with the consent of Council authorizes the use of all available resources of state government and political subdivisions to assist in the City's response to this situation; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRING VALLEY VILLAGE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The facts and matters contained in the preamble to this ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

**Section 2.** **Extension of Local State of Disaster.** That the local state of disaster previously declared for the City of Spring Valley Village pursuant to §418.108 of the Texas Disaster Act is hereby extended for 30 days from the date of this ordinance or unless terminated or modified by earlier ordinance of the City.

**Section 3.** **Publicity and Filing.** Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Disaster Act, this declaration of a local state of disaster due to this public health emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

**Section 4.** **Activation of the City Emergency Management Plan.** Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Disaster Act, this declaration of a local state of

disaster due to this public health emergency activates the City of Spring Valley Village Emergency Management Plan.

**Section 5. Temporary Housing and Emergency Shelter.** Pursuant to §418.020(d) of the Texas Disaster Act, this declaration authorizes the City to: (1) temporarily or permanently acquire by lease, purchase, or other means sites required for temporary housing units or emergency shelters for disaster victims; and (2) enter into arrangements necessary to prepare or equip the sites for installation and use of temporary housing units or emergency shelters, including arrangements necessary for the transportation and purchase of temporary housing units or emergency shelters.

**Section 6.** In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Spring Valley Village, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

**Section 7.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

## **ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-XX**

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING A CURFEW BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10:00 P.M. AND 6:00 A.M. NECESSITATED BY REASON OF DISASTER DAMAGE AND DESTRUCTION FROM SEVERE WINTER WEATHER; PROVIDING FOR PARTIAL OR TOTAL LIFTING OF THE CURFEW BY ORDER OF THE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.**

**WHEREAS**, by declaration issued on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2021, Mayor Marcus Vajdos declared a state of disaster for the City of Spring Valley Village, Texas resulting from the potential for prolonged freezing weather, broken pipes and power outages; and

**WHEREAS**, Greg Abbott, Governor of the State of Texas issued a proclamation on Friday, February 12, 2021 declaring a state of disaster for the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Valley Village has suffered or expects to suffer severe disaster damage and destruction from severe winter weather and there is the risk of vandalism and exposure of buildings to the natural elements, thus necessitating immediate protection against further loss; and

**WHEREAS**, the state of the disaster requires that certain measures be taken for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Spring Valley Village; now, therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPRING VALLEY VILLAGE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** It shall be unlawful for any person, without proper authority, to be upon the public streets or rights-of-way within the City of Spring Valley Village between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the next morning.

**SECTION 2:** This curfew and the hours of this curfew may be altered, changed, or lifted, by order of the Mayor at any time, but said curfew shall remain in effect until such order is made.

**SECTION 3:** Any person who shall intentionally, knowingly, recklessly or with

criminal negligence violate any provision of this Ordinance adopted under the emergency management plan shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in accordance with state law.

**SECTION 4:** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance should be declared invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance, because the same would have been enacted by the City Commission without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

**SECTION 5:** All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict only.

**SECTION 6:** This Ordinance shall be finally passed and adopted on the date of its introduction and shall become effective from and after its passage and adoption.
