



Precinct 3 Debris Response

Precinct 3 Residents,

Precinct 3 Road and Bridge crews and contracted trucks will be starting debris pick-up on Monday, May 20th. Our area stretches from The Villages up to Cypress, through Tomball, Spring, Humble, Atascocita, then down the San Jacinto River through Huffman, Crosby, Highlands, and Baytown to Channelview. We were especially hard hit in Cypress and The Villages areas.

We expect debris operations to last for weeks to months, so please be patient as we move through the affected areas. Each debris zone where debris has been reported will have assets assigned. Presence will be heavier in the most impacted areas.

The most impactful things you can do to help are as follows:

- **REPORT DEBRIS** to our hotline by calling 713-274-3880, this greatly helps with planning and staging of assets. You can also call Precinct 3 dispatch at 713-274-3100, if the debris hotline is busy.
- Follow the debris staging/sorting guidelines in the attached handout (vegetative, construction, appliances, electronics, hazardous)
- If at all possible, do not park cars on the street near or across from debris piles. Our trucks and equipment are very large and if an area is not able to be accessed we will have to return later once obstructions have been removed.

Please know that we understand how traumatic and disruptive an event like this can be. Many of our crews who will be working in your areas are also Precinct 3 residents with property damage and power outages... this makes us especially proud to be serving you. Thank you for your partnership in the recovery efforts.

Separating Your Debris

Debris should be placed curbside, without blocking the roadway or storm drains.

Debris collectors will make at least three passes in your area.

NO PICKUP ZONE

Any debris placed from the sidewalk toward your property will not be picked up.

DEBRIS SEPARATION

Separate debris into the six categories shown below.

DO NOT STACK OR LEAN

Placing debris near or on trees, poles, or other structures makes removal difficult. This includes fire hydrants and meters.

UNSURE WHERE TO PLACE DEBRIS?

If you don't have a sidewalk, ditch, or utility line in front of your house, place debris at the edge of your property before the curb. Use clear trash bags for loose debris.



Normal Household Trash

Normal household trash and bagged debris of any kind will not be picked up with disaster debris. You should continue to follow your normal garbage removal schedule.



VEGETATIVE DEBRIS

- Leaves (do not put in bags)
- Logs
- Plants
- Tree branches



CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS

- Building materials
- Carpet
- Drywall
- Furniture
- Lumber
- Mattresses
- Plumbing



APPLIANCES & WHITE GOODS

- Air conditioners
- Dishwashers
- Freezers
- Refrigerators
- Stoves
- Washers, dryers
- Water heaters



ELECTRONICS

- Computers
- Radios
- Stereos
- Televisions
- Other devices with a cord



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous Waste (HHW), such as paint (oil-based and latex), automotive chemicals, batteries, and lawn chemicals. HHW will not be picked up with regular debris piles. Harris County will notify all residents about HHW collection dates and drop-off locations.

Separando Sus Escombros

Los escombros deben ser puestos a la orilla de la calle, sin bloquear la carretera o alcantarilla. Los recogedores de escombros pasarán por lo menos 3 veces por su área.

ZONA QUE NO SERA RECOGIDA
Cualquier escombros colocado desde la acera hacia su propiedad no serán recogida.

SEPARACIÓN DE ESCOMBROS

Separe los escombros en las 6 categorías mencionadas abajo.

NO APILE O RECUESTE

Colocación de escombros cerca de o en árboles, postes, u otras estructuras dificulta el removerlos. Esto incluye hidrantes y metros.

¿INSEGURO DE DONDE PONER LOS ESCOMBROS?

Si no tienes una acera, zanja o línea de servicio público frente a su casa, coloque los escombros en el borde de su propiedad antes de la acera. Use bolsas de basura transparentes.



Basura Doméstica Normal

Basura doméstica y bolsas de basura de cualquier tipo no serán recogidas como parte de este programa. Debe seguir su programa normal de retiro de basura.

- Hojas (no las ponga en bolsas)
- Troncos
- Plantas
- Ramas de arboles



ESCOMBROS DE CONSTRUCCIÓN Y DEMOLICIÓN

- Materiales de construcción
- Alfombra
- Paneles de Yeso
- Muebles
- Madera
- Colchones
- Artículos de plomería



ENSERES Y ELECTRODOMÉSTICOS

- Aire acondicionados
- Lavadoras de platos
- Congeladores
- Refrigeradores
- Fogón/Estufa
- Lavadora, secadora
- Calentador de agua



ELECTRÓNICOS

- Computadoras
- Radios
- Equipos de sonido
- Televisores
- Otros artículos con cordones eléctricos



DESPERDICIOS PELIGROSOS DEL HOGAR

Desperdicios peligrosos del hogar (DPH) como pintura (de aceite ó látex), químicos de automóvil, baterías, y químicos de yarda. DPH no serán recogidos con los escombros. El condado de Harris notificará a los residentes las fechas de colección y punto de entrega de DPH.
